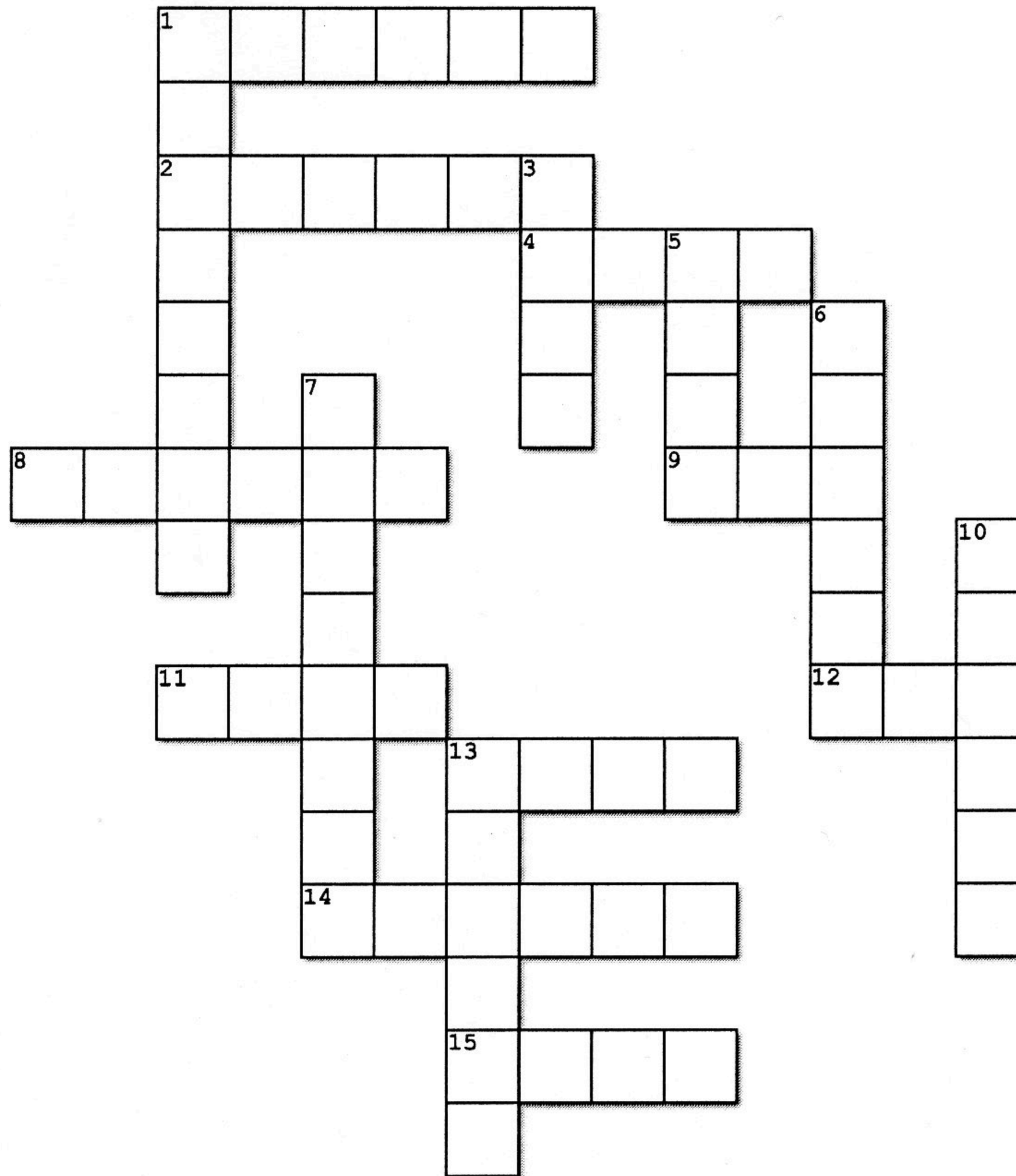


CJK 1 - Dreams and Experience
